It's been a long time coming, but someone has finally combined two of my favorite things: lesbians and Led Zeppelin. UK-based Lez Zeppelin has released a self-titled CD that pays tribute to the music that was forged by rock's original Hammer of the Gods and still leaves room for some interesting interpretations. And best of all, they look good while doing it!

Comprised of four young British lasses, LZ has the right amount of energy to pull off some pretty credible and difficult Zeppelin material without sounding screechy or comical. Less needs to be said about the group's sexuality, as they will neither confirm nor deny anything. What matters here is that the band can play, and play they do.

On the “Lez Zeppelin” debut, the girls rip through six of Zep's best-loved tracks plus a revised workout on “Winter Sun,” based on the Jimmy Page guitar solo “White Summer.” There's also one completely original track on the CD, the instrumental “On the Rocks,” which sounds like it would fit right into the outtakes from “Physical Graffiti.”

“The Ocean,” “Whole Lotta Love” and even the majestically enduring “Kashmir” are given the royal treatment. “Since I've Been Loving You” is done up sans organ but still manages to gather up all the ferocity of the original, thanks to Steph Paynes' hearty Gibson guitar.

If you think Lez Zeppelin is just a novelty act designed to rev up the hormones of pre-pubescent boys, think again. Famed recording engineer Eddie Kramer (Jimi Hendrix, The Beatles, Kiss) is sitting in the producer's chair, and he brings an air of authenticity to the proceedings.

Kramer worked on five of the original Zeppelin releases, so his presence (no pun intended) is noteworthy.

“Lez Zeppelin” is a fun CD and does a worthwhile job of covering some of the pillars in the rock 'n' roll

museum. There's nothing fluffy or patronizing about it. In fact, odd as it may sound, it has a LOT of balls!
